U.S./Saudi Genocidal War on Yemen

Since 2015, the United States has backed Saudi Arabia in a genocidal war against the people of Yemen. Providing arms, intelligence, and personnel to Saudi Arabia, the United States has made billions off this war, which is an attempt to crush resistance to U.S. imperialism and make Yemen once more a puppet state, annexed by Saudi Arabia.

Our Demands

- The U.S. must withdraw from the genocidal war on Yemen.
- All U.S. arms sales to Saudi Arabia must stop immediately.
- The U.S. must break ties with the fascist monarchy of Saudi Arabia.
- The U.S. must stop supporting Al-Qaeda and other right-wing terrorist groups.
- The U.S. must reverse its designation of the Houthis as a terrorist organization.
- The Saudi blockade and U.S. sanctions against Yemen must end.

Who are the Houthis?

Also called Ansar Allah, they are an indigenous people who stand against U.S. imperialism. They led the uprising in 2014 against the U.S.-backed government in Yemen. They established a government in northern Yemen and have been instrumental in fighting Saudi/U.S. forces and Al-Qaeda in the region. They are NOT terrorists—the U.S. and Saudi Arabia and their Al-Qaeda allies are.

Who are the real terrorists?

The U.S. and Saudi Arabia have targeted civilians in Yemen for half a decade and backed Al-Qaeda in southern Yemen.

Here are just some of the “terrorists” the U.S./Saudi forces have destroyed:

- A school bus with over 100 children
- A cholera treatment center
- Food supplies
- Sewerage treatment facilities
- A refugee camp
- Hospitals
- Mosques
- Wedding receptions
- Anti-terrorist Imam Salem bin al Jaber (murdered by drone strike)

Facts

- 20.5 million of the 29 million people living in Yemen lack access to clean water and sanitation
- Over 60% of the people are starving
- Half of the country’s healthcare facilities have been destroyed
- The Saudi blockade of air and sea ports blocks 90% of the country’s food and medicine imports
- 1.8 million children in Yemen suffer from malnutrition
- Over 2 million Yemenis have been displaced by the war
- Over 22 million Yemenis are at risk of cholera and starvation because of the disruption of international aid shipments



WORLD SAYS NO TO WAR ON YEMEN

The Yemeni people rise up against the U.S.-backed government in what the Yemenis call the September 21 Revolution.

September 21, 2014

Saudi Arabia, supplied with U.S. weapons, personnel, and intelligence by the Obama/Biden regime, intervenes in the Yemeni civil war in order to annex the country and re-establish imperialist control. Saudi Arabia begins a blockade of Yemen's ports.

March 2015



Amidst the worst cholera outbreak in recorded history, the Saudis bomb a cholera treatment center operated by Doctors Without Borders.

June 11, 2017

Trump and Saudi leader Mohammad bin Salman celebrate \$12.5 billion in U.S. weapons sales to Saudi Arabia.

March 20, 2018

The U.S. and Saudis bomb a school bus full of children, killing 50 and injuring 60 more.

August 9, 2018

Millions of people in Yemen march against U.S.-Saudi aggression.

September 2018



Imperialist journalist Jamal Khashoggi is murdered by Saudi Arabia. Western press expresses outrage over this, but not the millions of murdered Yemeni people.

October 2, 2018

The U.S. Senate passes Joint Resolution 54 in response to the death of Khashoggi, but does nothing to stop the war or the arms sales to Saudi Arabia.

December 13, 2018

U.S./Saudi forces bomb critical food supplies in Hodeida, Yemen, amidst one of the worst famines in history.

January 25, 2019

U.S./Saudi forces bomb a refugee camp in northwestern Yemen, a crime against humanity.

January 27, 2019

Italian dock workers strike, refusing to load ships with arms for Saudi Arabia.

May 21, 2019



The U.S. government designates the Houthis a terrorist group, blocking humanitarian aid from reaching the crisis-ridden northern areas of Yemen and escalating the massive death toll there.

January 10, 2021

An international day of resistance to the war is held as people all over the world demand U.S. AND SAUDI ARABIA OUT OF YEMEN!

January 25, 2021
